

**STUDENTS ENTERING OR
RETURNING TO CHEROKEE COUNTY SCHOOLS** *Policy Code:*

3426

Any student who has been home schooled or private schooled and wants to enroll in Cherokee County Schools must provide all regular enrollment information (birth certificate, social security number, immunization record, grade documentation, etc.). In addition, the student must take the appropriate locally adopted placement test and score at or above the grade level just completed. The student would then be enrolled in the next grade.

At the high school level, to enter grade 9, the student must score Level III or IV on the grade 8 Reading and Math EOG test. To enter grade 10, the student needs a passing score on English I and Algebra I and/or grade 8 Math. To enter Grade 11, the student must make a passing score on English I, Algebra I, and Biology. To enter grade 12, the student must make a passing grade on English I, Algebra I, Biology and US History. Additionally, documentation for all courses for which the student is seeking credit must be presented before course credit is granted.

Exceptional Children will follow guidelines established by Exceptional Children's policies and state and federal law.
